Ureteric stent for future replacement

Your ureter is your natural tube that connects the kidney to the bladder. This stent is a flexible plastic tube that is placed into your ureter and begins in your kidney and ends in your bladder, but is usually less than 3mm in width. We have placed this to ensure that your kidney is draining appropriately. They are **NOT permanent and must be removed or exchanged after a specified time**. If they are not exchanged this can lead to problems with you kidney function and the need for more complex surgery. They are usually exchanged every six months under a general or spinal anaesthetic using a telescope inserted into your bladder through your urethra.

What should you expect?

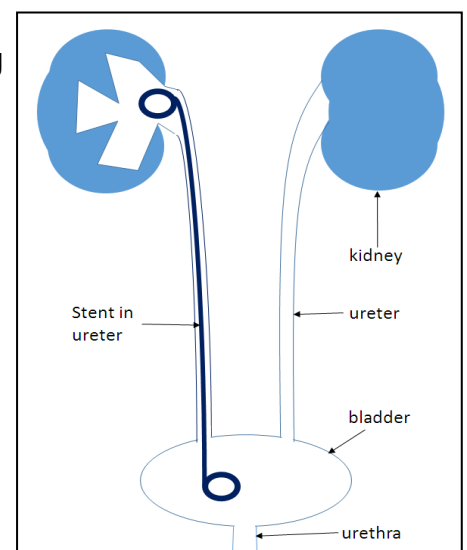
While you have the stent in your body you may have the following symptoms:

- Back pain towards the side, especially when you pass urine with pain in the bladder area
- Blood in the urine, increased frequency of urination and urgency of urination

When should you see a doctor urgently?

You should attend A&E if you have the following:

- Fever
- Inability to pass urine



What if I have not been sent an appointment for replacement?

You will be contacted by the admissions department with an appointment usually a month before your stent is due to be replaced. If you have not received an appointment by this time please contact admissions on 01727 897 666/4
